International Overdose Awareness Day: Honoring Lives Lost and Promoting Action

On International Overdose Awareness Day, communities across the globe will unite to remember those lost to overdose, reduce the stigma of drug-related deaths, and support those impacted by substance use. This annual event is the world's largest campaign to end overdose, raise awareness, and acknowledge the grief felt by families and friends.

The Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department, in partnership with local organizations, is hosting two community events to honor lost lives. Local organizations will promote life-saving resources, and speakers will share their personal experiences with substance use and overdose. Participants will also have the opportunity to receive training on Narcan, a medication that can reverse opioid overdoses.
