2026-2028 Community Health Improvement Plan Report & Virtual Q&A Sessions

The Community Health Improvement Plan is an assessment of health and a plan for improvement that health departments are required by law to assess every few years. Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department reviewed data gathered from surveys and community conversations and identified three key health priorities for 2026-2028: (1) Mental Health, (2) Nutrition, Physical Activity, and Obesity, and (3) Substance Use.
